
In-Office ECG Measurement

For patients who need ECG measurement and analysis during a scheduled office visit.

CPT® Code	Procedure Description
93040	Includes rhythm ECG tracing, interpretation, and report
93041	Includes ECG tracing only, without interpretation or report
93042	Includes ECG interpretation and report

30-Day Cardiac Event Monitoring

For patients who experience infrequent symptoms (less frequently than every 48 hours), suggestive of cardiac arrhythmias (i.e., palpitations, dizziness, presyncope, or syncope).



CPT [®] Code	Procedure Description
93268 / GLOBAL	External patient and, when performed, auto-activated ECG rhythm derived event recording; up to 30 days, 24-hour attended monitoring (includes connection, recording, scanning analysis with report, review, and interpretation by a physician or other qualified health care professionals)
93270 / HOOK-UP	Includes connection, recording, and disconnection
93271 / TECHNICAL	Includes transmission download and analysis
93272 / PROFESSIONAL	Includes transmission and analysis

1-2 Day Holter

For patients who experience frequent symptoms (more frequently than once in 48 hours), suggestive of cardiac arrhythmias (i.e., palpitations, dizziness, presyncope, or syncope).



CPT® Code	Procedure Description
93224 / GLOBAL	Electrocardiographic monitoring for up to 48 hours by continuous original ECG waveform recording and storage, with visual superimposition scanning; includes recording, scanning analysis with report, physician review, and interpretation
93225 / HOOK-UP	Includes hook-up, recording, and disconnection
93226 / TECHNICAL	Scanning analysis with report
93227 / PROFESSIONAL	Physician review and interpretation

Extended Holter

For patients with infrequent or frequent symptoms who need post-diagnostic, specific primary diagnostic or ambulatory ECG monitoring to characterize a non-life threatening cardiac arrhythmia (i.e., palpitations, dizziness, presyncope, or syncope).

93243 / TECHNICAL	Scanning analysis with report	
93244 / PROFESSIONAL	Physician review and interpretation	



8-14 DAY EXTENDED HOLTER

93245 / GLOBAL	Electrocardiographic monitoring for more than 7 days and up to 15 days by continuous original ECG waveform recording and storage, with visual superimposition scanning; (includes recording, scanning analysis with report, physician review, and interpretation)	
93246 / HOOK-UP	Includes connection and initial recordings	
93247 / TECHNICAL	Scanning analysis with report	
93248 / PROFESSIONAL	Physician review and interpretation	

Mobile Cardiovascular Telemetry

For patients with infrequent symptoms or who need ambulatory ECG monitoring to characterize a non-life threatening cardiac arrhythmia (i.e., palpitations, dizziness, presyncope, or syncope).

CPT® Code	Procedure Description
93228 / PROFESSIONAL	External mobile cardiovascular telemetry with electrocardiographic recording, concurrent computerized real-time data analysis and greater than 24 hours of accessible ECG data storage (retrievable with query) with ECG triggered and patient selected events transmitted to a remote attended surveillance center for up to 30 days; (review and interpretation with report by a physician or other qualified health care professional)
93225 / TECHNICAL	(Technical support for connection and patient instructions for use, attended surveillance, analysis, and transmission of daily and emergent data reports as prescribed by a physician or other qualified health care professional)
